As part of the project activity the Board organized one day training programme to the selected agencies to understand the methodology for preparation of database on tradable bioresources along with their economic valuation and associated traditional knowledge held on 03-06-2015 at TSBDB, Hyderabad.

Dr. C. Suvarna, IFS, Member Secretary, Telangana State Biodiversity Board welcomed the gathering and briefed about the provisions of the Biological Diversity Act, 2002, Rules for access to biological resources and/ or associated knowledge for research or bio-survey and bio-utilization for research, and highlighted the need for conservation of biological resources from the exploitation. The Member Secretary shared various experiences and interacted with the members of the BMC.

After that Mr. G. Sailu, State Project Coordinator gave a brief presentation on Biological Diversity Act, Rules and ABS guidelines. He explained about the functions of the BMC as per the Biological Diversity Act. He also mentioned that if any biological resources are accessed by the industry for commercial purpose.

After that Mr. V. Linga Rao, RBC-1, TSBDB, gave a brief presentation on the conservation of medicinal plants and their importance.
